Murray Bridge Cods Swimming Club trains swimmers to compete at a National level with qualified coaches. Our swimmers compete across the state in various club carnivals and meets, Country, State and School Championships.

What will you get

Stroke Correction

Our qualified coaches will analyse your technique and give you tips to correct them.

Dive From Blocks

Competition swimming requires a swimmer to dive from a block, blocks are not readily available at most pools, swimmers will have a chance to try diving from the blocks.

Learn The Rules

Our coaches will let you know what the most common reasons for disqualifications in a swim heat so you can be aware of what will cause a potential disqualification.

Club Night /Point Score Night

Pointscore Club Nights are an informal introduction to competitive swimming where the swimmer is only competing against themselves!

The night is run as close to carnival conditions as possible so swimmers (and parents / caregivers!) experience what will happen at higher level meets - including entering online via Swim Central!

The simple goal of Pointscore swimming is to better your time every meet. You will gain points for competing, if you better a previous time or if you progress to the next distance.

Pointscore Club Nights will all follow the same format: All four (4) strokes (Free, Back, Breast and Fly) and a Distance Event. Everyone is encouraged to 'have-a-go. Your coach will guide you in deciding if to do the distance event: Seniors – It is expected that you will do it!

There are three (3) standard distances: 25m, 50m and 100m. Once you achieve the progression time you move up to the next distance. The Distance event is open to anyone.

Progression Times are as follows: Or you could even call it qualifying time.

Freestyle 25m 29 sec 50m 45 sec Backstroke 25m 34 sec 50m 53 sec Breaststroke 25m 41 sec 50m 58 sec Butterfly 25m 33 sec 50m 48 sec

You must break the progression time to advance. E.g. you must swim 50m Freestyle in 44.99 seconds or less to advance to the 100m distance. Swimming it in 45.01 will not advance you.

If you achieve the progression time you cannot swim the next level until the next meet.

23/02/2024 free, back, breast, fly and 400m free 15/03/2024 free, back, breast, fly and 50m HCP & Relay Trophies awarded for these on presentation night.

Enter via Swim Central, choose up to three (3) strokes you wish to swim (eg Free, Back and Fly - Ignore the 50m distance!).

New swimmers will be allocated a distance based on coaches' discretion.

To enter the Distance Events see the Recorder on the night.

50m HCP and Relay entries will only be taken in the two weeks prior to the meet

Let it be noted, these rules only apply to club night, carnivals and meets kids can swim what ever they choose, if available on Swim Central then they can swim that distance, any uncertainty talk to your coaches.
